Nestled in the foothills of the Shivaliks, The Kikar Lodge- India's first Private Forest Reserve is spread over 1800 acres and is, located barely a few kilometres from the shimmering blue band of the "Ropar Wetlands". The Kikar Lodge attempts to evoke unity with nature and divinity within oneself.

Activities

- **Bird watching:** There are a number of species of birds in the forest.
- Billiards, pool, swimming, table tennis.
- **Off road Quad biking (ATV):** Experience the sheer thrill of riding a four-wheeled motorbike through the lower Shivaliks Mountains.
- Bush walks in the reserve: They are a number of trails for visitors ranging from plain trails to mountainous. They are graded from 1-5. One being the easiest and five being the hardest.
- Visit a royal bath over two hundred old located on a mountaintop in the middle of the forest.
- Sacred well: Guru Gobind Singh the tenth Guru of the Sikhs visited the well over three hundred years ago on his way to Chiri Sahib. The well is located in the middle of the property.
- Horse trails.
- Conference rooms.

- Yoga and Meditation.
