



Magic mukteshwar

Sixty kilometres from Nainital perched on Mukteshwar ridge, engulfed in apple and peach orchards – this resort is the perfect place to commence - or conclude - your stay.

In winter, one can enjoy the cosy log fire , while outside the snow is piled deep. In spring, the gardens are full of apple blossoms, and the air is scented with thyme and sage. During the monsoons in July and August, the hills are shrouded in clouds, lush and saturated by the cleansing rain. And from July to September, the area lives up to its name as 'the fruit basket of Kumaon', with apples, apricots, plums and pears in abundance. Autumn is glorious, with crisp frosty nights and golden days – makes mukteshwar is truly a place for all seasons.



Accommodation/facilities

The resort consists of ten double rooms, of two four bedded units with en suite bathrooms, hot and cold running water and verandas. The resort is surrounded by flower gardens and apple orchards, from where, on a clear day, you can enjoy stunning views of the snowy Himalayan peaks in the distance. Other facilities include conference/club room for indoor sessions



Activities

The various activities available at the Mukteshwar are – picnic lunches , morning leisure walks for sunrise, evening sunset views, treks to chauli kaa jaali, bon fire, music evening, yoga sessions, village interaction adventure elements like rock climbing and rive crossing can be arranged on request
