

"Snow View" is one of the thirteen cottages built by J.H. Abbott the founder of this small hill station. On a clear day from September to May, one can see an unobstructed view of the higher Himalayas, from the Gangotri massive on the left to the Dhaulagiri range on the right. A panoramic view of 600 kilometers of snow covered Himalayas with Nanda Devi and Panchachuli at the centre. It is the ideal place for a holiday without any distractions, especially for those who want to paint and read and write - far from the crowds and distractions of the 'rat race'. It's a perfect retreat for families from the long hot summers of the plains. It's the type of place where one could comfortably reside for a week or a couple of months at a stretch. Though we believe once exposed to its charms you prefer the later.

Abbott Mount has changed little since its inception. There are only thirteen secluded cottages spread over this private hill. "Snow view" cottage was built by J. H. Abbott for his son and daughter in law. There is a picturesque church set amidst the forest and an ancient cricket pitch with an unsurpassed view of the mountains



Accommodation

The house is perfect for one or a large family. It is fully furnished and can sleep up to eight. It has a large living and dining area with two bedrooms that share one bathroom. There is a separate Utility wing adjacent to the main house that has the kitchen, servants quarters and garage. The living and dining areas have large picture windows that look out at the mountains and onto the lawn.
